

THE JOURNEY WITH THE STUDENTS

The Butterfly Project aims to involve students and high schools in writing an Opera on an ecological theme and in its production in terms of sustainability. The high schools which took part in the project are:

- High School Francesco Selmi Modena
- High School no.6 Gdańsk
- Otaniemen Lukio High School Helsinki

The subject of the Opera, whose working title is "Elements for the Future", is inspired and built around a natural element (water for Gdańsk, air for Helsinki and earth for Modena). The storyline will be the result of the creative work of the students who, starting from the environmental aspects, were able to draw on a multidisciplinary investigation with the support of their teachers. Then the development of the libretto and of the compositions will be entrusted to musicians and librettists from the three partner opera houses of the project (Municipal Theatre of Modena, Baltic Opera in Gdańsk and Opera Box in Helsinki).

Out of nine proposals, three stories were selected to become part of the Opera: "Pearl of Hope" (Italy), "The Lake of Ashes" (Poland) and "The Prince of Harmony" (Finland).

The **Digital Book** represents a comprehensive collection of all the students' stories which were submitted for the Project Butterfly, as their inspirational ideas will promote good practices to support **sustainable opera creation**.

THE ITALIAN STUDENTS' STORIES

1. PEARL OF HOPE
